

THE TIMOTHY N. TIMM MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

One full tuition scholarship will be awarded each year to a deserving student. The student must be a returning Zion student and entering Grades 4, 5, 6, 7, or 8.

The primary indicator will be excellence in academic achievement in mathematics. The student must have earned an A or A+. Only the exiting grade year levels will be included. This will be verified by the student's Zion Lutheran School report card.

A student must submit the following documents in one complete packet to be eligible for the Timothy N. Timm Memorial Merit Scholarship:

1. The student must submit an essay that includes the following information:
 - a. Evidence for personally living Zion Lutheran School's Expected Schoolwide Learning Results (ESLRs): Zion C.A.R.E.S. (Zion's students are Christ-centered academic achievers and responsible citizens with exceptional character and servants' hearts.) This evidence must show that the student exemplifies a Christian life through personal integrity, leadership activities, and service to their school, community, or world at large.
 - b. The student's written personal statement of faith.
2. The student's pastor must write a letter to the scholarship committee providing evidence that the student is an active member of the student's family church.
3. In addition to the above, the student must submit two Zion teacher recommendations:
 - a. One recommendation should reflect outstanding achievement in courses such as language arts, mathematics, science, history, geography, and any other courses that reflect Zion's core curriculum. This judgment must be supported by tangible evidence of results on teacher-made tests, portfolio assessments, and/or special projects.
 - b. The second recommendation should address involvement in community service or co-curricular activities including on-campus service, local community service, and/or demonstration of creativity and achievement in technology, foreign language, visual arts, or performing arts.

School personnel may consider, as part of these criteria, activities in which a student demonstrates high motivation, initiative, integrity, intellectual depth, leadership qualities, outstanding attendance, and/or exceptional judgment.

Fully complete packets must be submitted to the Principal by Friday, July 29, 2011, at Zion Lutheran School, 1405 E. Fallbrook Street, Fallbrook, California 92028. (No partial packets will be accepted.) A decision will be made by Friday, August 5, 2011.
