System Requirements To access Rosetta Stone®, sign in to your Rosetta Stone® Classroom portal at: <http://zionlutherschool.rosettastoneclassroom.com>



Click on the **[First Time Users]** tab and **[Check System Readiness]** to check your computer system to make sure it has the necessary resources to run Rosetta Stone®. You will most likely need to download and install the “Speech Component”.

Headsets: Your child can use Rosetta Stone® with basic speakers and a simple microphone. If you would like

to invest in a USB headset with microphone, I suggest the following “Cyber Acoustics AC-850 USB Stereo Headset” from www.amazon.com or comparable headset (about \$25).
